Monitoring Guide for the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education (ECHE)

The Erasmus Charter for Higher Education (ECHE) provides the general quality framework for European and international cooperation activities a higher education institution may carry out within Erasmus+. The award of an ECHE accreditation is a pre-requisite for all higher education institutions located in an EU Member State or third countries associated to the Erasmus+ programme and willing to participate in learning mobility of individuals and/or cooperation among organisations and institutions under

Erasmus+. To make sure the monitoring is objective and based on clearly established parameters, the National Agencies have at their disposal a series of evaluation grids that are annexed to this guide.

The project partner, Digital Learning Network ETS of the EU funded project 'ONLIFE', organized the Final Conference, in Brussels.

The Cypriot Member of the European Parliament Costas Mavrides, host of the Conference at the European Parliament, in his greeting spoke about the importance of the project results. He stressed the fact that the specific project results prove that a problem can become an opportunity and thus the pandemic, in this case, can be a springboard for the development of educational skills, in the online teaching process in school education.

The initiative for the presentation of the results of the project at the European Parliament belongs to Dr. Gregory Makrides, president of Cyprus partner European Association of Career Guidance, on behalf of the 8 partners from Poland, Belgium, Greece, Spain, Romania, Cyprus and 2 from Italy.
