They are part of the Erasmus Without Paper network, which is working to help HEIs to manage their Erasmus+ student mobility administration more efficiently and securely online.

Updating the Inter-institutional agreement EWP API (Version 7)

The update aligns the EWP Network with the new <u>Erasmus+</u> template for inter-institutional agreements, published in early 2023, and enables additional functionality and technical updates. The changes, decided through the EWP Governance, aim to enforce clearer data standards, and improve interoperability and usefulness for colleagues in higher education institutions (HEIs).

ERASMUS+ EUROPEAN UNIVERSITIES CALL

• This Erasmus+ call for proposals comes with a total budget of €189,2 million.

 It runs from 3 October 2023 to 6 February 2024.

The call will allow the European Universities initiative to expand to at least 60 European Universities alliances with more than 500 universities by 2024.

PROJECT ACTIVITIES

The Green Roofs Technician Training project, aims to develop an innovative training course, methodology and a new, multidisciplinary occupational profile, specialized in green roofs. The partnership is currently working on the first project result; the Training Course and Platform Development.

The project results are:

- 1. Green Roofs Training Course and Platform Development
- 2. Green Roofs Trainers' Handbook
- 3. Guidelines for Green Roofs Training

The first result encompasses two components:

- (1) A training course on Green Roofs and
- (2) An eLearning environment.

The course will train a new, multidisciplinary professional profile, specialized in rooftop farming and gardening, what we call a Green Roof Technician.
