ETRe Project 5th and final Project Meeting

The final project meeting of ETRe took place in London, UK, 27 March 2023. "Empowering schools' transition readiness to a distance/hybrid learning model enhanced by cloud technology tools", is addressed to educators, educational organizations, decision makers, and school principals, aiming to:

- create a framework of digital competences and a set of the characteristics of an educational digital tools repository,
- explore the importance and the add-on value of the available open source tools,
- empower educators by offering a set of easy-to-read information for tools,
- develop a guide on how to adapt the suggested framework within a classroom
- **develop a distance/hybrid learning certification** process for a school organisation to set a standard for schools that wish to achieve an adequate level of readiness.
